All members that do not want their newsletter via email will continue to receive a paper copy like this one on a monthly basis. Based on membership response we estimate that over 50% of our members are interested and that will potentially reduce newsletter expenses by \$75 per month or \$600 per year.

For those of you that are interested, the newsletter will be sent via email with an attached PDF file (Adobe Acrobat). PDF files are a universal file type and can be read on most computers.
