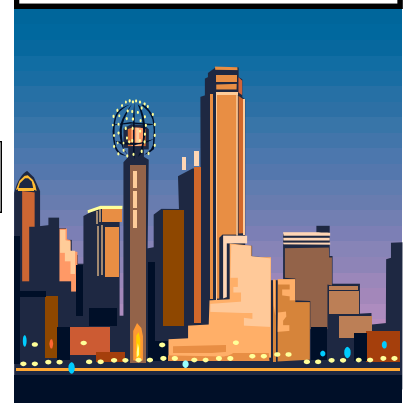
Service Week-Downtown Daily Bread March 15-19, 2004

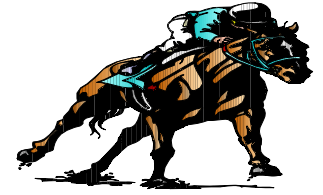

The Harrisburg and Lancaster Chapters are sponsoring an evening at the Penn National Race Course on Friday, April 30, 2004, beginning at 6:00 p.m. We will be in the Turf Club, a private room overlooking the race track. Happy hour will begin at 6 p.m. A buffet dinner will start at 6:30 p.m., followed by live racing action starting at 7:25 p.m. A cash bar and betting window will be close by for your convenience. Test your skills or luck selecting the horses, or just enjoy the view of charging thoroughbreds from the large glass panels overlooking the track.

The cost is \$22.00 for Chapter members and members of other local chapters, and \$24.00 for non-members. The price includes Clubhouse admission, the Winners Circle buffet dinner, and a racing program. The buffet includes: Top round beef, stuffed chicken Florentine topped with Mornay sauce, Fusilli pasta in a tomato cream sauce, roasted red potatoes, seasonal vegetables, tossed salad, assorted miniature desserts, rolls and butter, regular/decaf coffee, iced and hot tea. *(Vegetarian meals are available upon request)*. The Penn National Race Course is located off Exit 80 of I-81. From I-81 heading north, turn left off the exit ramp. Then turn right at the first Penn National Entrance.
