The Harrisburg Chapter of the Penn State Alumni Association has chartered a bus to Boalsburg and State College for the Arts Festivals. The trip will take place Saturday, July 12th. The bus will leave the Harrisburg East Mall Parking Lot, **light pole 32**. The bus will leave promptly at 8:30 am, so don't be late!! A light breakfast will be served on the bus. You can choose to be dropped off at the craft fair in Boalsburg for 3 hours and then continue on to State College, or you can choose to spend the entire day at the Arts Festival in State College. **The Central Pennsylvania Festival of the Arts** is an annual celebration of the visual and performing arts that takes place each July in downtown State College and on the adjacent campus of Penn State. The Festival attracts about 100,000 visitors to State College each summer. The Festival includes the nationally recognized Sidewalk Sale and Exhibition, which is a juried outdoor show of quality fine art and fine crafts, approximately 325 exhibitors. The festival also includes music, dance, and theatrical performances. **The People's Choice Festival of Pennsylvania Arts & Crafts**, takes place at the Pennsylvania Military Museum Grounds in Boalsburg, PA. It runs at the same time as the Central Pennsylvania Festival of the Arts and to showcase the creativity and workmanship of artisans living in Pennsylvania. It is estimated that more than 80,000 people visited the festival in 2001. The 2001 festival featured 162 artists, 48 musical performances taking place in two entertainment tents, a demonstration village, food vendors' booths, a young artisan sales area, and numerous youth activities.
