Cancellation of Chapter Events



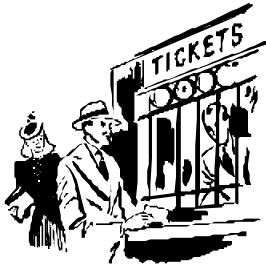

sure if tours like we had scheduled will be allowed to happen in the future or not. If they are we will definitely add it to our events as soon as possible.

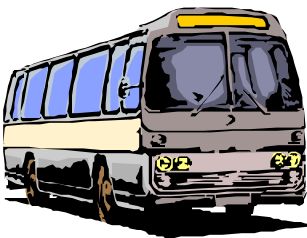
